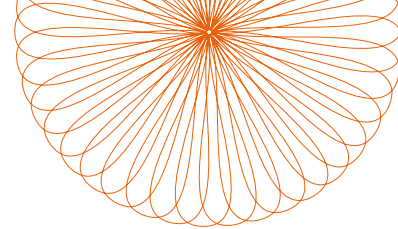
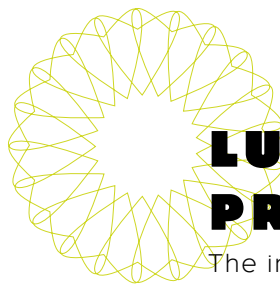




# LUX HELSINKI 4.-8.1.2013



## LUX HELSINKI 2013 PROGRAMME

The installations can be viewed as non-stop performances between 4pm and 10pm. Please refer to the descriptions below for any possible exceptions. Changes to the programme are possible.

### 1. SENATE SQUARE

CASA MAGICA: EMERGENCE

A video projection on Helsinki Cathedral and sound effects in the square create a new experience for viewers. Duration: approx. 10 min.

### 2. KIASMA FORECOURT

FIRE TROUPE ETNA: KEHRÄ

The Fire Troupe Etna demonstrates the interaction between fire and light. Performances daily from 4 to 8 January 2013 at 6:30pm and 7:30pm.

### 3. KIASMA

HEIKKI PAASONEN & JANI-MATTI SALO:

LINEAR ARRAY

Dozens of fluorescent lamps light up the façades of Kiasma and Sanomatalo, highlighting the architectural rhythms and forms.

### 4. KANSALAISTORI

JENNI KÄÄRIÄINEN: SODIUM SUN

Recycled low-pressure sodium lamps create a familiar coloured sun in the night sky over the city centre. The full effect of the installation can be experienced from Kansalaistori.

### 5. BAANA/ KANSALAISTORI

MIKA HAARANEN: MEMORY OF STONE

The surfaces of the stone bridge at the gateway, Baana, are brought to light. The installation can be viewed from Kansalaistori.

### 6. BAANA

DAN SHORTEN: REVEAL

An interactive video mapping installation close to the Parliament House extension along Baana, the new pedestrian and cycle corridor. Viewers can interact with the installation with their own movements.

### 7. GALLERIA NUNES

NICOLAS JARCIC: 4 WORKS

The world of light, video and illusion is presented in a gallery close to the installations along Baana, Pohjoinen Rautatiekatu 17-A a. Open daily 12noon-10pm.

### 8. HAKASALMI VILLA

TWINSEN HO: LITTLE SPIRITS

The fairy-tale atmosphere created by this light installation is best experienced in the garden at Hakasalmi Villa.

### 9. HESPERIA PARK

MULTIPLE ARTISTS: LANTERN PARK

Lanterns conjured up by art students and lighting professionals light up the path between the Finnish National Opera and Finlandia Hall, leading viewers to Mannerheimintie. The lanterns illuminate the park throughout the night.

### 10. FINNISH NATIONAL OPERA AMPHITHEATRE

PHILIPPE MORVAN: COSMOGOLE

The cosmic atmosphere of this light and sound installation lets the imagination run wild. The installation can be viewed from inside the Amphitheatre and from the park.

### 11. OLYMPIC STADIUM TOWER

JUKKA HUITILA: VARIANT SPECTRUM 2

The colours of the spectrum light up the tower, while a laser beam is projected over the city. Viewed from the base of the tower the installation is an intense experience, but it can also be appreciated from a distance.

### 12. CITY CENTRE

AINU PALMU: PINK CARAVAN

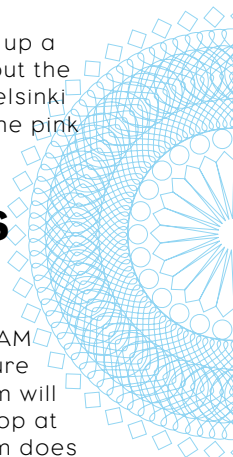
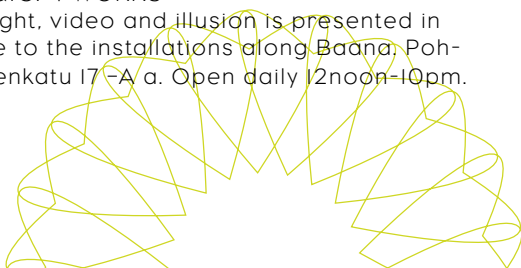
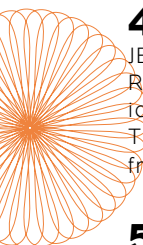
